The state of Kansas has been trying to get legislative authority to issue single-family mortgage revenue bonds and start a program of their own. If that happens the County's program would likely never get additional allocation from the Kansas Department of Commerce which would result in a dead resource.

Wanda Hicks was awarded the Maintenance Person of the Year award. She was nominated by her supervisor, the Executive Director of the Colby Housing Authority.
